Make your own Halloween costume

Rubik's Cube:

Box of Tissues:

Find a cardboard box that is large enough to fit over your body and cut holes for your arms and legs. Paint it pastel colors or cover with flowery wallpaper. Add the logo of your favorite tissue company. Take a beanie or other kind of hat and cut a slit into the top. Stuff some tissue underneath, with one sticking out, so people can pull tissues out of your head.

APPLE PIE PARTY DIP

INGREDIENTS FOR DIP

- 1 1/3 cups peeled diced apples
- 1 tsp. fresh lemon juice
- 2 tsp. brown sugar
- 2 tsp. apricot preserves
- 1/8 tsp. cinnamon

INGREDIENTS FOR CHIPS

- 5 flour tortillas
- 2 tbsp. butter, melted
- 1/2 tsp. cinnamon
- 1 1/2 tbsp. sugar

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Combine all the dip ingredients in a bowl, then cover and refrigerate the mixture until chilled.
2. Brush the tortillas with butter, then cut them into wedges
3. Arrange the wedges on a greased baking sheet, sprinkle with cinnamon and sugar, and bake 350 until

golden brown, about 10 minutes. Let them cool before serving. Serves 4 to 6
